



The Message Is

What is “The Message”?

It is the return of the Lord Jesus Christ in Word form.

That might sound a bit scary for some, as if this is a secret cult out to trap members but in fact this has been a transparent, open, world wide, proclamation.

And it is scriptural.

By that I mean it not only follows the patterns set in the Bible but it also fulfils Bible prophecy. And no, we are not after members we just want people to meet God.

But firstly the patterns.

The Bible pattern for the coming of Christ is to have the spirit of Elijah come first to prepare the way. John the Baptist had that spirit at His first coming.

And we can see that same spirit operating just before the physical second coming of the Lord in Revelation 11. Here God’s two witnesses have power to bring a range of plagues on the earth and to stop the rain for 3½ years and destroy their enemies with fire. The witness with all the plagues is obviously Moses, the other, who in Old Testament times both stopped the rain for 3½ years and had fire destroy his enemies was Elijah.

The pattern then is that if Jesus is to return then Elijah must first come.

Most Christians see that the secret coming of Jesus Christ, when He comes as a thief to take steal away His precious Bride, is close. That can be seen by world events, the return of cities and civilisations to Sodom and Gomorrah like lifestyles and marriage a remarriage as at the time of Noah.

Jesus Himself confirmed that, “*Elias truly shall first come, and restore all things.*” (Matt 17 v11) and neither John the Baptist nor the Elijah of Revelation 11 restore anything, they rather proclaim what for their audience are new things. It follows then that the restorer is for the secret coming just before judgment and Armageddon.

Malachi 4 v5 & 6 says “*Behold, I will send you Elijah the prophet before the coming of the great and dreadful day of the LORD: And he shall turn the heart of the fathers to the children, and the heart of the children to their fathers, lest I come and smite the earth with a curse.*”

Luke 1 v17 tells us that John the Baptist fulfilled the “*turn the heart of the fathers to the children*” part of Malachi 4 v6 so the “*turning the heart of the children to their fathers*” was still to be fulfilled.

The Elijah of Revelation 11 preaches the Christian message to the Jews so he doesn’t fulfil that scripture. But the Elijah of the secret coming will as prophesied by Revelation 10 v7. “*But in the days of the voice of the seventh angel, when he shall begin to sound, the mystery of God should be finished, as he hath declared to his servants the prophets.*”

So the Elijah mentioned here will turn the hearts of the children back to the fathers. In other words he will restore the original faith of the Church Fathers to Christians (the children) of today. Elijah, or someone with the spirit of Elijah will preach and teach the same Word of God that the original Apostles preached.

So the Word will be restored, and Jesus is the Word of God. That means that Jesus will return in Word form. The Elijah of Revelation 11 is preceded by the Elijah prophet of Revelation 10 v7. And that seventh angel, or messenger, introduces the mighty angel of Revelation 10 v1 who is Jesus Christ. And the people who accept the mystery of God as revealed through that seventh angel must, like

the writer of Revelation, the apostle John, take the book from Jesus and eat it. And a book contains words. This is The Book, The Word! Who had this Elijah spirit? William Marrion Branham.

His ministry from 1947 to 1965 went seven times around the world, and the messages he preached are recorded on tapes (CDs now of course) film and in books.

We don't look to the preacher or prophet anymore than the Apostles of old stayed looking at John the Baptist. The messenger came to point to Jesus, not to himself.

And for us today Jesus is revealed in the Word Brother Branham preached as he is simply restoring us to a living relationship with the Living Jesus Christ of today. For a true prophet is only a mouthpiece for God to operate through. And the mouth of a true prophet speaks the Word of God, and the Word of God is Jesus Christ.

He has returned.
