



The Beginning

Before there was even a beginning there was God.

No, that's not right.

God is an object of worship and before there was anything to worship Him He already was. He must therefore be eternal spirit. The Bible name for the eternal spirit is Elohiym, (pronounced El – o-heem) and that is the word translated as God in the Bible. But before anything there was Elohiym, alone. In Him were the attributes to be God, to be Saviour, redeemer, healer, father, son, and much, much more. For these attributes to become reality Elohiym had to think of a way. He thought and planned. Then He had to make those thoughts real, He had to manifest those thoughts. He could have done that in any way, but he chose to speak those thoughts. The revealing of His thoughts by spoken Word is Jesus Christ. Jesus is the original thoughts of God made reality, He is the eternal spirit Elohiym expressed.

Jesus then created the angels. Now there was something to worship Him.

But God wanted more. So Genesis 1 v1, *"In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth."*

No time is given for this. We don't even know what that world looked like or how it perished but something happened for by verse 2 *"... the earth was without form, and void; and darkness [was] upon the face of the deep."*

That doesn't sound like a creation still in God's control. Formless voids, and darkness is a sign that God wasn't there for God is light, order, reason.

The spirit of God hovered over the waters and began a new creation, and there follows the Creation story of Genesis from verse 3 to 31. Those six days of creation referred to in II Peter 3 v6 say that those days were one thousand years long. The present world was created in six thousand years, built upon the remains of a previous world.

Plants and creatures were created to inhabit the waters and the land till finally God created man in His own image. This was spirit man. Then God took dust and chemicals from the earth and placed the man in the body He had created for him.

Man, in the image of God was lonely. All the animals had partners he had none so God took the feminist side of Adam and separated it into a body built up from a physical part of Adam.

So Eve came from the original Adam, she was a part of him in the beginning, and that original Adam was the image of God. If Adam is the image of God and his wife came from him then where was God's bride at that time? In Him?

Jesus tells the story in Matthew 13 of the man who sowed good seed in his field. An enemy came later and sowed tares, weeds. The good seed are the children of God, the tares are the children of the Devil. And the serpent beguiled Eve and Adam knew his wife Eve and she brought forth twins; two boys each with a totally different nature. One was a shepherd, the other a hard working crop farmer. Both were religious but one had a revelation that blood was needed to cover sin, the other thought sincerity and good works would be enough. Abel's sacrifice was accepted, Cain's was not and in a fit of envy he killed his brother Abel. Religious Cains have always tried to kill those with the truth. (John 8 v44)

Jesus Christ suffered the same fate as Abel. Like Cain the Pharisees were religious and when Jesus was obviously accepted by God they had Him murdered.

Like Adam then Jesus Christ was put to sleep. His side was opened and from those wounds blood and water flowed down. And the result was the Church, the group of people who were to become the body of Christ.

His death on the cross was a new beginning. This was the beginning of the new creation, the people to inhabit the New Jerusalem; the Bride of Christ. Those eternal thoughts that were with Elohiym before this creation are quickly becoming a reality for the next.
