And our planet Earth is not just another planet. It is perfectly designed for life. The chances of another planet Earth occurring by chance are about one in more than all the atoms in the universe.

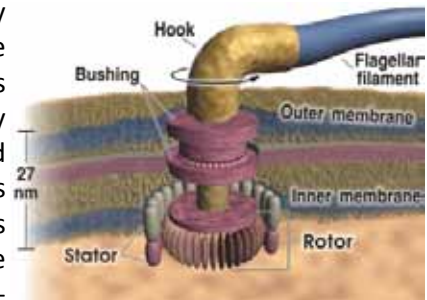

We are shown Darwin's tree of life with twigs reaching out in a massive diversity of life from many branches to a thick trunk. Over billions of years many small changes would produce new life forms. Firstly, assuming the current geological time frames, there isn't billions of years for evolution. There is 500 million at the most; and that is no where near long enough.. Palaeontology, the study of fossils, has found that, other than simple life forms, such as bacteria, all complex life arrived at pretty much the same late geological time. This Cambrian rock strata reveals fully developed creatures, many of

which are identical to today's examples. There is no evidence whatsoever of any gradual development of evolving life. According to the fossil record life has not moved from simple to



the complex. As a result if Darwin's tree were re-drawn it would have no trunk or branches. Secondly, armed with extremely powerful microscopes micro biologists can now see molecular machinery in use in everything from an E-Coli bacteria to a human cell. The E-Coli bacteria has a tail driven by a machine that resembles a miniature electric motor. That motor has some forty separate parts making such things as a stator, bearings, u joint, rotor, it is water cooled, spins at up to 120,000 revolutions per minute and can go from forward to reverse in a quarter of a turn. It is the most efficient motor known in the universe. The point is that to develop incrementally in an evolutionary way each part has to bestow an advantage. But the advantage to the E-Coli only comes if the whole motor is complete, fully developed and in place. In this example it is shown that the E-Coli tail, a living organ, cannot be formed in small incremental



steps. Darwin's own test proves that his theory of evolution has utterly broken down.

Then there is adaptation. But once again Darwin's theory of random changes are found to be false. It now seems that specie adaptive abilities are built into a creature's genetic computer code. It is all pre-programmed. If a change in environment, food, temperature, occurs then an IF THEN switch within the DNA code triggers a range of changes to allow that creature to survive.
